Why are we praying Bible verses?

1. Gain confidence in your prayers.

When you pray God's truth—His very own Words—over your life, you can pray confidently because you know God's Word is true. Agreeing with God's Word is powerful!

2. Increase Your Praise of God.

Praising God doesn't come naturally to most of us (no, it's not just you.) Yet, the key to experiencing joy in all circumstances is rejoicing in God.

3. Know God better.

Praying Scripture helps inscribe God's Word on our hearts, which allows us to know God better. We learn about His character (why we can trust Him), and we learn about His desires (who He wants us to become, and what He wants us to do).

4. Change your perspective on life.

Praying Scripture reminds us of the bigger story. God has a plan for each and every one of us—a good plan—but we lose sight of that when we're in the middle of a difficult situation or feeling stuck in the mundane.

5. Gives you the strength to endure hard times.

The Bible assures believers of God's omnipresence—He is with us always! Scripture is also full of truths we can cling to when life gets hard. God gives strength, act as a stronghold, brings peace, gives rest, and delivers His children from the enemy.

Here are a few things to think about for your prayer adventure:

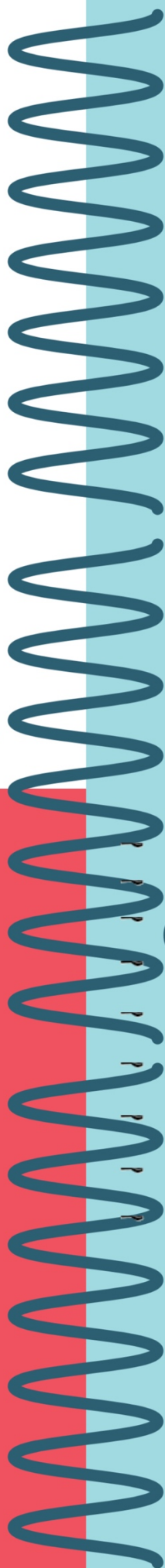
